## The parties

- New Zealand Tramways and Public Passenger Transport Employees¹
  Union Weilington Branch Incorporated (Tramways)
- 2. Tranzit Group Limited, Tranzurban Upper Hutt Limited, Tranzurban Wellington Limited and Tranzurban Hutt Valley Limited.

## Background

- A. Tramways has applied for an order against Tranzit under matter number 3026453 requiring it to bargain with it. Tramways has also sought orders claiming that it and the applicants are entitled to benefits or enforceable rights under a contract between Tranzit and the Greater Wellington Regional Council ("GWRC").
- B. Tranzit denies that bargaining has been validly commenced, and says that neither Tramways nor its members have enforceable rights arising under the contract between it and GWRC.
- C. The parties have agreed to settle the issues arising in matter number 3026453.

## Terms of settlement

- 3. In consideration of Tramways withdrawing the said matter:
- a. Tranzit and Tramways agree to settle the issue relating to commencement of bargaining on the basis that initiation notices sent on 29 January 2018 are deemed to be of effect on 15 March 2018.
- b. Tranzurban Wellington Limited and Tranzurban Hutt Valley Limited and Tramways will commence bargaining within seven days of this agreement being signed by the parties to seek a collective agreement to agree the employment terms of Tramways' members.
- c. Tranzurban Wellington Limited and Tranzurban Hutt Valley Limited and Tramways will bargain in good faith and in accordance with their mutual obligations including, in particular, the collective bargaining provisions of the Employment Relations Act 2000.

d. Costs in respect of matter number 3026453 will lie where they fall.
